Home Committee Meeting News September

Cash Audit conducted with following reported as of September 9th: Checkbook Balance \$9,674.47, Credit Card Account \$6,642.66, Savings Account balance \$6,421.58. No pending deposits. Total cash on hand \$30,238.22.

Financial Audit We have not received financial statement from the accountant, no report.

We will be celebrating the Navy's Birthday with a cake cutting at the Home on Friday the 14th of October at 1800. The Branch Christmas Party is scheduled for the 9th of December.

At the September General Assembly there was a final reading of the proposed Home By-Laws changes. These changes are to update our By-Laws to match our operations. They are as follows;

Section 702 – Removes Building fund wherever it appears, Changes amount required in savings account to \$5,000 vice \$20,000.

Section 704 – Deleted – Building Fund Section

Section 802.1&2 - \$2,500 changed to \$3,000 to match section 604.2

Section 803.1 - \$2,500 changed to \$3,000 to match section 604.2

Note from the Chairman – The home has been operating in a trying to survive mode since COVID. Come the first of the year our License and Insurances become due. Last year that amounted to over \$34,000. It will probably be more next year. Several month's ago, we were granted permission by the general assembly to obtain a loan of \$50,000. We will be working on that over the next several months.

Thanks to S/M Tim Bailey, our Cook and Lady Linda Cox for a great cleanup of our kitchen area. We will be posting a time for us to continue this work with the help of anyone who would like to help.
