Financial Audit The following balances as of November 30 2022; the checking account \$11.117.05, the credit card account \$6,422, the savings account \$11,117.24, our cash on hand \$1,947.05, net profit for the month of \$3,236.50. The balances for December were, checking account \$5421.11, the saving account \$6,423.73, credit card account \$17,019.88. Our cash on hand \$4,732.77, net profit for the month of December was \$6,561.10.

The **Battle of Iwo Jima** (19 February – 26 March 1945) was a major battle in which the United States Marine Corps (USMC) and United States Navy (USN) landed on and eventually captured the island of Iwo Jima from the Imperial Japanese Army (IJA) during World War II. The American invasion, designated **Operation Detachment**, had the purpose of capturing the island with its two airfields: South Field and Central Field.

The flag raising was on February 23. The battle continued until 26 March.

Operation Homecoming was the return of 591 American prisoners of war (POWs) held by North Vietnam following the Paris Peace Accords that ended U.S. involvement in the Vietnam War.
